

Exodus Period: Main Events

1446 BC (Exodus 7—Numbers 14)

- Moses leads the Hebrews out of Egypt (1st month (Abib), 15th day) *Exodus 7-13*
- Israel crosses the Red Sea *Exodus 14:21-27*
- Bitter waters of Marah become sweet *Exodus 15:25*
- From Elim to Wilderness of Sin (2nd month, 15th day) *Exodus 17:7*
- Moses smote the rock of Horeb, and water came out *Exodus 17:1-7*
- Begin travel to Sinai in third month *Exodus 19:1*
- Moses receives the Law at Mt. Sinai *Exodus 19-24*
- 12 spies sent into Canaan from Kadesh-barnea *Numbers 13:1-33*
- Israel rebels and refuses to enter Canaan *Numbers 13-14*
- Israel wanders in the wilderness for 40 years (1446-1406) *Numbers 15-19*

1406 BC (Numbers 14—Joshua 6)

- Israel returns near the border of the Promise Land *Numbers 20*
- Moses sinned smiting the rock instead of speaking *Numbers 20:1-13*
- Fiery serpents and the serpent of brass *Numbers 21:5-9*
- Balaam, the donkey, and the curse turned blessing *Numbers 22*
- Israel enters the Promise Land *Joshua 6*

1406 BC—1399 BC (Joshua 6—12) 7-year conquest
