

PETER'S DENIALS (PASSAGES)

<p>Mt.26:31-35 ^{31a}Then Jesus said to them, "you will all fall away because of Me this night, for it is written, 'I WILL STRIKE DOWN THE SHEPHERD, AND THE SHEEP OF THE FLOCK SHALL BE SCATTERED.'"</p> <p>³²But after I have been raised, I will go before you to Galilee."</p> <p>³³But Peter answered and said to Him, "Even though all may fall away because of You, I will never fall away." ³⁴Jesus said to him, "Truly I say to you that this very night, before a cock crows, you shall deny Me three times." ³⁵Peter said to Him, "Even if I have to die with You, I will not deny You." All the disciples said the same thing too.</p> <p>Mt.26:58 But Peter also was following Him at a distance as far as the courtyard of the high priest, and entered in, and sat down with the officers to see the outcome.</p> <p>Mt.26:69-75 ⁶⁹Now Peter was sitting outside in the courtyard, and a certain servant-girl came to him and said, "You too were with Jesus the Galilean." ⁷⁰But he denied <i>it</i> before them all saying, "I do not know what you are talking about." ⁷¹And when he had gone out to the gateway, another <i>servant-girl</i> saw him and said to those who were there, "this man was with Jesus of Nazareth." ⁷²And again he denied <i>it</i> with another, "I do not know the man." ⁷³And a little later the bystanders came up and said to Peter, "Surely you too are <i>one</i> of them; for the way you talk gives you away." ⁷⁴Then he began to curse and swear, "I do not know the man!" And immediately a cock crowed.</p> <p>⁷⁵And Peter remembered the word which Jesus had said, "Before a cock crows, you will deny Me three times." And he went out and wept bitterly.</p>	<p>Mk.14:27-31 ²⁷And Jesus said to them, "You will all fall away, because it is written, 'I WILL STRIKE DOWN THE SHEPHERD, AND THE SHEEP SHALL BE SCATTERED.'"</p> <p>²⁸But after I have been raised, I will go before you to Galilee."</p> <p>²⁹But Peter said to Him, "Even though all may fall away, yet I will not." ³⁰And Jesus said to him, "Truly I say to you, that you yourself this very night, before a cock crows twice, shall three times deny Me." ³¹But Peter kept saying insistently, "Even if I have to die with You, I will not deny You!" And they all were saying the same thing, too.</p> <p>Mk.14:54 And Peter had followed Him at a distance, right into the courtyard of the high priest; and he was sitting with the officers, and warming himself at the fire.</p> <p>Mk.14:66-72 ⁶⁶And as Peter was below in the courtyard, one of the servant-girls of the high priest came, ⁶⁷and seeing Peter warming himself, she looked at him, and said, "You, too, were with Jesus the Nazarene." ⁶⁸But he denied <i>it</i>, saying, "I neither know nor understand what you are talking about." And he went out onto the porch; [and a cock crowed, <i>majority text</i>] ⁶⁹And the maid saw him, and began once more to say to the bystanders, "This is <i>one</i> of them!" ⁷⁰But again he was denying it. And after a little while the bystanders were again saying to Peter, "Surely you are <i>one</i> of them, for you are a Galilean too." ⁷¹But he began to curse and swear, "I do not know this man you are talking about!"</p> <p>⁷²And immediately a cock crowed a second time. And Peter remembered how Jesus had made the remark to him, "Before a cock crows twice, you will deny Me three times." And he began to weep.</p>	<p>Lk.22:34 And He said, "I say to you, Peter, the cock will not crow today until you have denied three times that you know Me"</p> <p>LK.22:54-62 ⁵⁴And having arrested Him, they led Him away, and brought Him to the house of the high priest; but Peter was following at a distance.</p> <p>⁵⁵And after they had kindled a fire in the middle of the courtyard and had sat down together, Peter was sitting among them. ⁵⁶And a certain servant-girl seeing him as he sat in the firelight, and looking intently at him, said, "This man was with Him too." ⁵⁷But he denied <i>it</i>, saying, "Woman, I do not know Him." ⁵⁸And a little later, another saw him and said, "You are <i>one</i> of them too!" But Peter said, "Man, I am not!" ⁵⁹And after about an hour had passed, another man <i>began</i> to insist, saying, "Certainly this man also was with Him, for he is a Galilean too." ⁶⁰But Peter said, "Man, I do not know what you are talking about." And immediately, while he was still speaking, a cock crowed. ⁶¹And the Lord turned and looked at Peter. And Peter remembered the word of the Lord, how He had told him, "Before a cock crows today, you will deny Me three times." ⁶²And he went out and wept bitterly.</p>	<p>Jn. 13:38 Jesus answered, "Will you lay down your life for Me? Truly, truly, I say to you, a cock shall not crow, until you deny Me three times."</p> <p>Jn.18:15-18 ¹⁵And Simon Peter was following Jesus, and so was another disciple. Now that disciple was known to the high priest, and entered with Jesus into the court of the high priest, ¹⁶but Peter was standing at the door outside. So the other disciple, who was known to the high priest, went out and spoke to the doorkeeper, and brought in Peter. ¹⁷The slave-girl therefore who kept the door said to Peter, "You are not also <i>one</i> of this man's disciples, are you?" He said, "I am not." ¹⁸Now the slaves and the officers were standing <i>there</i>, having made a charcoal fire, for it was cold and they were warming themselves; and Peter also was with them, standing and warming himself.</p> <p>Jn.18:25-27 ²⁵Now Simon Peter was standing and warming himself. They said therefore to him, "You are not also <i>one</i> of His disciples, are you?" He denied <i>it</i>, and said, "I am not." ²⁶One of the slaves of the high priest, being a relative of the one whose ear Peter cut off, said, "Did I not see you in the garden with Him?"</p> <p>²⁷Peter therefore denied <i>it</i> again; and immediately a cock crowed.</p>
