HOLY SPIRIT

- The Holy Spirit proceeds silently and invisibly from the Son.
- He does not embody the Son.
- He issues from the Father, through the Son.
- He continues to influence man with regard to the Son.
- He helps man to live in the Son.

- The Son perpetually reveals the Father.
- It is in the Son that the Father becomes a part of human life.
- The Son exists as long as the Father exists.
- The Son is co-existent with the Father.
- Chronologically, we experience the Son first.
