And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof? — (Re.5:2)	Executes the judgment of God 
And after these things I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree. — (Re.7:1)	Praise for God's judgment of sin 
And when he had opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven about the space of half an hour. — (Re.8:1)	Prayers of the saints answered in judgment against unrighteousness (Ps.74:10;89:46; 94:3) 
And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit. — (Re.9:1)	Executes the judgment of God 
And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire: — (Re.10:1)	Executes the judgment of God 
And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever. — (Re.11:15)	Announces coming judgment 
And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels, — (Re.12:7)	Heavenly angelic conflict 
And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people, — (Re.14:6)	Executes a series of judgments 
And one of the four beasts gave unto the seven angels seven golden vials full of the wrath of God, who liveth for ever and ever. — (Re.15:7)	Executes the judgment of God 
And I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the seven angels, Go your ways, and pour out the vials of the wrath of God upon the earth. — (Re.16:1)	Executes the judgment of God 
And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither; I will shew unto thee the judgment of the great whore that sitteth upon many waters: — (Re.17:1)	Angels and John witness God's judgment on Babylon 
And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory. — (Re.18:1)	Announces the fall of Babylon 
And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God; — (Re.19:17)	Announces final judgment of Armageddon 
And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. — (Re.20:1)	Imprisons false prophet, antichrist, and satan
